1. **SET UP DATES AND TIMES:**

The show decorator will install its pipes and drapes so that exhibitors can set up their exhibits:

Friday, January 14, from 2:00 to 6:00 pm

Saturday, January 15, from 7:00 to 11:00 am

Security will be in effect during these hours. Exhibits must be ready by 11:00 a.m. Saturday, January 15. (please refer to move in/move out procedures enclosed)

2. **EXHIBIT HOURS:** Saturday, January 15.....11:00 am. to 5:00 pm
Sunday, January 1611:00 am to 4:00 pm

3. **REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS:**

Exhibits must not be disturbed, dismantled or removed before 4:00 pm on Sunday, January 16, However, the exhibits must be dismantled and packed and removed before 6:00 pm on Sunday, January 16. (please refer to move in/move out procedures enclosed)

4. **BOOTHS:**

All individual exhibit spaces measure 10 feet wide by 8 feet deep. The booths will have 8' high backdrop draping & 3' high side rail draping. Each booth will be equipped with one 7" x 40" exhibitor ID sign, one 8' table skirted, two chairs and a wastebasket.

6. **UTILITIES:**

General illumination is in the convention center. One 110 volt outlet is available for an additional \$65.00 if paid with your contract by December 15, 2022. After that date, the rate is increased to \$100.00 and we must make arrangements with the Convention Center. Services are available from the Riverside Convention Center for telephone, audiovisual and computer equipment, cleaning service and custom floral. If you desire any of these services, please contact the Convention Center at 585-232-7200 x 1429.

7. **SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Exhibitors may send freight directly to the Riverside Convention Center on a pre-paid basis no more than 2 days ahead of the event. Contact them in advance to make arrangements. It must be sent to the attention of **NYSAAF Trade Show**.

8. **LOUNGE AREA:** We will have a lounge area as part of the trade show (including a snack bar) where exhibitors can take a break. This will help to retain delegates in the trade show area and offer a location away from the booths to discuss business.

9. **TRADE SHOW PRIZE DRAWING:**

Once again there will be a special drawing for NYSAAF delegates. It is scheduled for Sunday, January 16, 3:30 p.m.

10. **REGISTRATION:**

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING EXHIBITORS

Only members of NYSAAF are Eligible for Booth space Booth size 8" x 10"

1. **Occupancy of space:** Exhibit space not occupied by 11:00 am on the date of show will be released for resale and no refunds will be made, Space must be occupied on each day of show.
2. **No assignment of space:** Space contracted for the herein may not be transferred, assigned, sublet or shared with others, All demonstrations or other sales activity must be confined to the limits of the exhibit space. No exhibitor is permitted to show goods other than those manufactured, sold or represented by it in the regular course of business.
3. **Exhibitors shall maintain their displays** in a quiet and orderly manner. Live entertainment performing and demonstrations will be limited to presentations which do not disturb adjacent exhibitors and their patrons. The operation of musical instruments and PA systems are prohibited in the exhibit hall. Audio or Video presentations must be arranged so that the sound will not disturb adjacent exhibitors and their patrons. NYSAAF reserves the right to require changes or deletions in an exhibitor's display if in the judgment the exhibit is disruptive to adjacent exhibitors and /or patrons and/or general welfare and safety of the same or if the exhibit is not as represented at the time of execution of this contract and exhibitor hereby grants said right to the NYSAAF and agrees to conform to and abide by requirements.
4. **Admission will be by badge only.** Identification badges are not transferable.
5. **Insurance:** The exhibitor assumes responsibility and agrees to indemnify and defend the NYSAAF and their respective employees and agents against any claims or expenses arising out of the use of the exhibition premises. The exhibitor understands that the NYSAAF does not maintain insurance covering the exhibitor's property and it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain such insurance. Exhibitor agrees to add NYSAAF as an additional insured on its liability policy for the term of the show and provide certificate of insurance.
6. **Circulation and solicitation.** Exhibitors must operate from within the contracted booth. Distribution of circulars or promotional material from any other area is prohibited. Solicitation of donations is prohibited at the show.
7. **Removal of Exhibits:** Exhibits must be removed from the exhibit hall in an orderly manner from 4 pm to 6 pm on closing day of the trade show. Exhibitor agrees to completely remove all material installed by it or third parties at its request without damage or disruption to the building.
8. **NYSAAF Does not guarantee or covenant to protect exhibitor against loss of any kind.** It does agree, however, that limited security will be provided for the exhibit hall. Exhibitor understands that the NYSAAF owes no other duty to the exhibitor in that regard and exhibitor on behalf of itself and all owners of the property in possession of exhibitor and all persons brought by exhibitor onto premises, waives and releases any and all causes of action and claims against NYSAAF or any employees thereof and exhibitor consents not to sue NYSAAF or any employees thereof and to look solely to said security agency or other parties for satisfaction of any claims or causes of action.
9. **Right to termination etc.** It is understood that in the event exhibitor fails to comply with any of the terms of this contract, including but not limited to the rules and regulations of the NYSAAF, NYSAAF reserves the right to terminate this contract and exhibitor and its exhibit, employees, and agents shall be immediately removed from the exhibit hall at exhibitor's expense and this contract shall be terminated. NYSAAF has the right, but not the obligation, to remove or cause same to be removed, at exhibitor's expense if the exhibitor fails to do so immediately and exhibitor hereby waives and releases any and all causes of action or claims of action or claims of any nature arising out of same and all payments previously made by exhibitor to NYSAAF shall be forfeited and retained by NYSAAF without further obligation to the exhibitor. Afterwards NYSAAF shall have the right to use said space as it sees fit, including but not limited to use for other exhibits and exhibitor shall not be entitled to any credits or refunds, this contract having been terminated. The reservation and granting of the above rights are deemed by the parties to be in addition to any other rights which NYSAAF may have under this contract or otherwise, the intent of the parties being to not preclude or exhaust any rights of NYSAAF or claims for damages by NYSAAF whatsoever.
10. **Any checks received for payment** of exhibit space that is returned for insufficient funds or reason, will automatically result in cancellation of contract for exhibit space by NYSAAF,
11. **Full payment must be received by NYSAAF** before booth space shall be occupied by the exhibitor,
12. **Termination of exhibit space contract within 60 days** of show by exhibitor will result in no refund of monies being made by NYSAAF, unless the entire show is sold out.
13. No verbal understanding shall modify or add to this contract, any amendments hereto must be in writing, If the holding of the trade show for the year named shall be canceled for any reason, the trade show management may refund on this contract and cancel same without further obligation,

RULES FOR NOMINATION OF NYSAAF HALL OF FAME AWARD

In recognition of devoted and invaluable service to the NYSAAF and one of its member Fairs, an annual award will be presented to individuals who exemplified and distinguished themselves by their commitment. The presentation of the award will be made to the recipients at the banquet during the annual Convention. The award will consist of a plaque with the recipient's name inscribed thereon. The recipient's name will be added to the NYSAAF Hall of Fame.

ELIGIBILITY

The conditions of eligibility are as follows:

- The nominee must be living.
- The nominee shall have served as a Director, Officer, Volunteer, Staff Member, Friend of a Fair, or Manager of a NYSAAF member Fair.
- The nominee shall have been supportive in the affairs of the NYSAAF.
- The nominee must have shown consistent and significant service to the NYSAAF and one of its member Fairs.
- The nominee must be nominated by a minimum of three NYSAAF member Fair representatives or two member Fair representatives and one NYSAAF Associate member.

NOMINATIONS

The procedure to be followed by the Awards Committee in the selection of a candidate shall be as follows:

- Each year, the Awards Committee shall announce that the nominations are being received for a period prior to the annual Convention. Nominations must be received by December 1st of that year. A nomination form will be mailed to each member Fair and be available on the NYSAAF website for Associate members to nominate.
- Nominations for the award should be returned with a record of the nominees achievements in the fair industry in sufficient detail so that a committee can pass judgment on the candidate's worthiness to receive the award. Also, be sure to include a biography of the person being nominated for use in the presentation. This record of achievement will be prepared by a representative of a NYSAAF member fair with two additional member Fairs or one additional Fair and one additional Associate member named as references.
- The Hall of Fame section committee will be made up of the Chairman, Executive Secretary, 2nd Vice President, 3rd Vice President, immediate past winner. It will be the prerogative of the President of the NYSAAF to name additional members to the selection committee. All nominations will be forwarded to and results tabulated by the Executive Secretary of the NYSAAF.
- All questions coming before the Awards Committee shall be decided by a majority vote of the Committee. The Awards Committee shall have the power to decide any questions not specifically covered by these rules.
- The applications for nomination must be submitted annually. They will not be kept on file for future consideration. (Effective 1/1/2016)
- There will only be one recipient annually. In the unlikely event that there are no applications received, the Hall of Fame Committee will not appoint a winner. Even if there are applications received, it should be up to the Hall of Fame Committee to decide if there is a nomination worthy of the award. The Hall of Fame Committee should not have to make an award if they do not feel they have a worthy candidate. (Effective 1/1/2016)
